

WELCOME TO THE 59TH ANNUAL ART IN THE PARK FESTIVAL BENEFITING BOULDER CITY HOSPITAL

For many in our Southern Nevada community, a treasured indication that Autumn is officially on the way appears as temperatures start to lower, days get a bit shorter, and the beloved Boulder City Art in the Park makes its appearance the first weekend of October. Not only is it an art lover's dream come true, but it's also the anniversary of the signature fundraising event hosted by the Boulder City Hospital Foundation with all proceeds benefiting Boulder City Hospital.

Boulder City Hospital (BCH) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, private Critical Access Hospital (CAH) with 25 acute/swing beds, 10 acute psychiatric beds, 47 Long Term Care beds and more than 250 staff. Our Hospital is not supported by a taxing district, corporate healthcare system, or mining dollars and relies on donations from the community and the efforts of the Boulder City Hospital Foundation.

The Boulder City Hospital Foundation is a separately registered nonprofit 501(c)(3) charitable organization established in 1995 to raise funds for capital equipment and improvements in support of our community Hospital and in the past five years has raised over \$1.5 million through fundraising events such as Art in the Park, the Heart of the Community Gala, and Annual Appeal.

The annual Art in the Park festival draws up to 100,000 visitors and is comprised of a varied and exciting range of fine art, fine craft, and traditional artists along with a midway of culinary delights and live entertainment. It is widely recognized as the largest outdoor art festival in the Southwest! This year's event features hundreds of artisans located throughout the heart of Boulder City among its four beautiful parks. It's simply amazing that the Boulder City community has spent the past half century ensuring its residents are provided with superior healthcare and it all started from humble beginnings.

Reaching back to the 1930's when Hoover Dam was a project guided by the WPA, thousands of workers descended upon the area to build one of the major marvels of the world at the time. Due to the strenuous, and often times dangerous, work involved, the Government set up a facility to treat the workers associated with the project.

As the early 50's rolled around, and with the Dam project long completed, it was decided by the government to close the Hospital facility. When the residents of this quaint, beautiful town heard the news it sent them into a grassroots mode with the sole aim of saving the Hospital and establishing a nonprofit resource for its residents. Through hard work and innovative thinking, the Women's Hospital Auxiliary organized the first Art in the Park event in 1962 in Ralph and Sarah Denton's back yard to go along with other fundraising events.

As one of the city's largest events, Art in the Park wouldn't be successful without the combined efforts of members of our communities. It is the hard work of the Boulder City Hospital Foundation, Hospital staff, Boulder City Chamber of Commerce, Boulder City Police and Fire Departments, Boulder City Parks and Recreation, and the City of Boulder City, who make this festival successful. Everyone who can help comes out to set up the area days before the show. Countless hours of setting up booths, registering hundreds of artists and being sure that every little detail is covered.

A full spectrum of artists and craftsmen can be found at this spectacular event. Guests shop and indulge in delectable fare and refreshments at any number of food and beverage booths. Art in the Park always features a variety of food choices from hot dogs, hamburgers, roasted corn on the cob, barbecue sandwiches, Italian, Mexican, Greek, and Chinese fare to desserts and ice cream. Entertainment is a standard at Art in the Park. While strolling the parks and viewing artist works, quests are welcome to relax in the shade at Bicentennial Park with refreshments while enjoying the stage entertainment from Boulder City's gazebo. Since the inception of the festival every talented artist has donated one original piece to the Art in the Park raffle. That tradition continues today, making every raffle prize a "hot treasure!" Raffle tickets are available at the raffle booth at the west end of Bicentennial Park. Raffle winners will be notified by phone and may pick up their prizes at the event or at the Boulder City Hospital Foundation office.

Artist Spotlight – Ryan Rabbass

This Year's Featured Artist, Available at Booths #49 & 59 in Wilbur Park The Future of Fine Arts

Ryan Rabbass, this year's featured artist, is a Vegas artist who has been working over 20 years sharing his art and design in a variety of forms. As a child, Ryan realized he wanted to be an artist when he created his first series of drawings to present to his grandmother. From childhood, Ryan has always sought to mix art into everything that he does. In school, he continued to draw and paint, but also take computer and electronic classes. After attending college for graphic design, Ryan worked at a number of casinos where he provided design work and sold his own street art at local shows and fairs.

Salvador Dali, Vladimir Kush, Greg Simkins, and Daniel Wall are some of Ryan's artistic influences. Ryan loves to interweave different elements into his creations. He began by capturing his love

of rock and roll into visual arts paintings. He then evolved into exploring more popular culture themes such as those in

Wizard of Oz and Alice in Wonderland. Ryan seeks out inspiration from whole worlds such as those from Marvel, Pirates of the Caribbean, and Harry Potter. Tapping into existing worlds communicates immediate shared meaning with the audience, and also provides a fantasy doorway for viewers to emotionally emerge themselves in.

These works of art are not merely the images presented, but also the large size and proportion of canvas. Ryan puts considerable time and thought into calculating how every aspect of each work will go together. Indeed, many times he begins design by considering the ration of the canvas, deciding what color scheme would best work, and then finding an appropriate theme.

Ryan blends surrealism with realistic subject matter to create invocative portraits, animal scenes, and above all else – fully realized fantasy landscapes.

In addition to exploring different themes, Ryan has also sought to explore different mediums for his paintings, especially in the realm of technology. Artificial intelligence, AI, has transformed people's understanding of art and our relationship to created works. Ryan seeks to utilize these tools while providing additional value that can only come from human touch.

Many of Ryan's creations come from researching online, using AI drafts for brainstorming, and then creating custom works in his home art studio. For example, he often uses cutting edge printing and then paints texture with traditional paint onto canvas. As the influence of AI grows on the fine arts world, innovative techniques will continue to require human ingenuity.

This year's poster and shirt feature the piece Locomotive Breath.

Beautiful Distraction is a three dimensional piece with a wood base. Each component piece was individually mapped by computer, then manually traced. Using a scroll saw, Ryan cut the various shapes and then nailed them down. Ryan used modeling paste and then added detail with additional layers. The result is a stunning example of combining traditional fine arts with computer technology to produce a fantasy landscape.







Less than half will seek treatment.
